



Questions and Answers on Changes to Club Management

What is the change?

As of March 12th, the Dorval Municipal Tennis Club Committee (the Committee) has dissolved, transferring management responsibilities of the Dorval Municipal Tennis Club (the Club) to the City of Dorval (the City).

What does it mean to me?

The City will now oversee the Club's operations. It will ensure a continued high-quality tennis experience for all members during the 2024 outdoor season and beyond. The Committee will assist in this transition as a support team.

What prompted this change?

For reasons including alignment with other sports organizations and liability concerns, the City presented the Committee with two options: either become an independent non-profit organization with added responsibilities or relinquish all tasks to the City.

How did the Committee respond?

The Committee proposed a revised distribution of responsibilities, but the City declined it during a meeting with the Committee on March 12th, 2024. This led to the Committee's dissolution and the City assuming full Club management.

Why did the committee hand over responsibilities?

Committee volunteers already manage numerous tasks, and taking on additional responsibilities would strain it and future recruitment. Moreover, many of the additional tasks which were proposed for the Committee are typically managed by the City in comparable facilities such as pool and soccer field monitoring and maintenance.

How will members be represented in this new structure?

The Committee will support the City in knowledge transfer and task transition. It's open to volunteering for certain tasks if requested by the City. The Committee may transition into a new organization to represent the players with the city and possibly convert the DMTC Facebook page into a "DMTC Players Club" Facebook group.



Who can address specific inquiries?

The City is committed to maintaining an exceptional tennis experience and will provide answers in due course.

Club Opening: The City will provide updates.

Registration: Details will be available soon.

Contact Information: Contact details will be provided.

Representation: The City will address members' interests.

Court Reservations: The city will confirm if and how this will be done.
